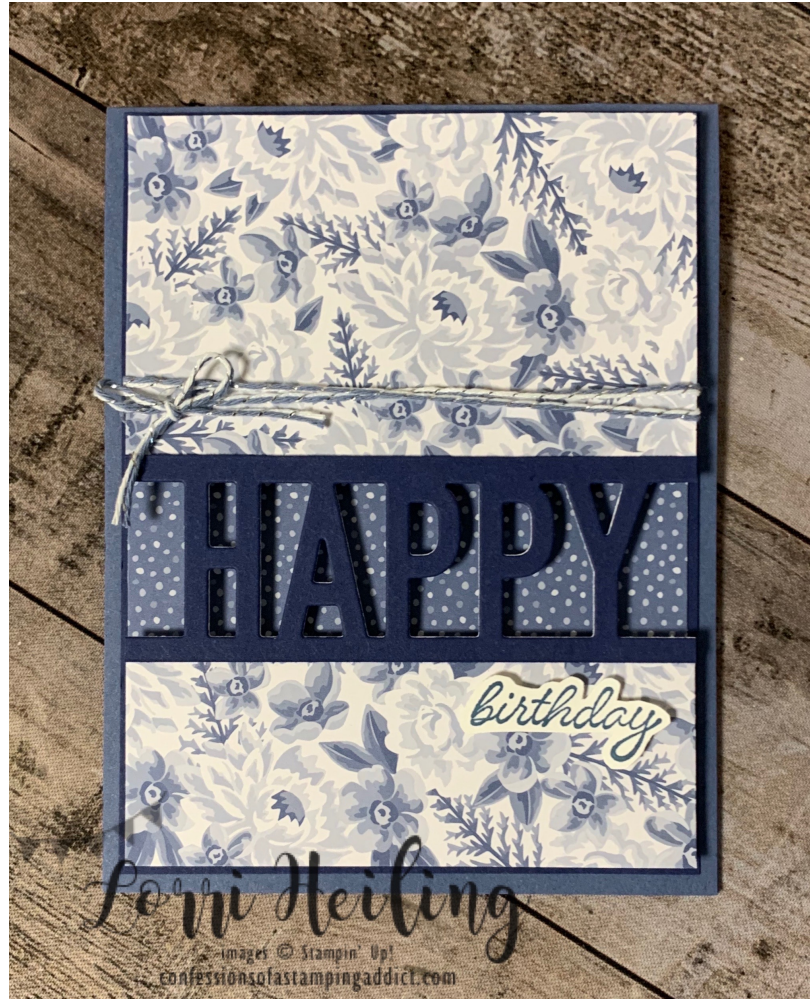


So Much Happy Card



Instructions:

- Cut 4 ¼" x 11" Misty Moonlight cardstock, score in half on long side, and fold on score line
- Cut 4" x 5 ¼" Night of Navy cardstock
- Cut 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" Flowers for Every Season Designer Series Paper
- Set "HAPPY" die on DSP about 1 ½" from bottom edge and die cut
- Cut 4 ¼" x 2" Night of Navy cardstock and die cut "HAPPY" words – position die so top of die matches top of cardstock
- Trim bottom part of this using Stampin' Trimmer, so there is a 3/16" base edge, just like the top
- Adhere to HAPPY that was die cut out on DSP, trimming sides of navy cardstock so it matches edges of DSP
- Cut (2) pieces of Misty Moonlight/Silver Baker's Twine 4 ½" long and adhere to DSP as shown, adhering on the back side and crossing over each other to form an "X"
- Tie a bow using 2 strands of Baker's Twine and adhere to card front using Mini Glue Dot
- Cut 3 7/8" x 1 ½" DSP (I used polka dot print) and adhere to Night of Navy cardstock – before adhering, line it up so it is positioned under the word HAPPY, then adhere
- Adhere DSP to Night of Navy cardstock using Foam Adhesive Strips to give this layer a POP!
- Adhere this to card front
- Stamp the word "birthday" on Whisper White cardstock scrap and fussy cut around letters
- Adhere to DSP using Dimensionals
