

# Easter Bunny Chocolate Bar

**Stamp Set:** Best Dressed

**Paper:** Daffodil Delight, Highland Heather, Basic White, Peony Garden Designer Series Paper

**Ink:** Memento Black, Daffodil Delight, Highland Heather, Mint Macaron Blends

**Misc:** 5/8" White Polka Dot Tulle Ribbon, Build a Wreath Dies, All Dressed Up Dies, Dimensionals, Multipurpose Liquid Glue

## Instructions:

- Print bunny ears and Easter egg pattern on page 2 of instructions and fussy cut
- Trace inside and outside bunny ear pieces on to Peony Garden DSP and fussy cut
- Adhere these two pieces together
- Cut 2 1/4" x 3/4" Basic White cardstock, the project will be adhered to this piece, which you won't see when finished
- Adhere 2 ears to white cardstock
- Die cut 2 easter eggs using Build a Wreath Dies – mine are Magenta Madness and Highland Heather and adhere to white cardstock piece
- Trace larger egg from pattern below on to Daffodil Delight cardstock, fussy cut, and adhere to white cardstock piece using Dimensionals
- Stamp flower image on scrap Basic White cardstock using Memento Black Ink
- Stamp insides of flowers using Daffodil Delight, Highland Heather and Magenta Madness inks and color leaves using Mint Macaron Blends
- Die cut flowers using All Dressed Up dies
- Adhere flowers to white cardstock
- Tie white ribbon around candy bar into a bow
- Adhere Easter bunny ear piece to chocolate bar, and making it bow out a bit to give it a 3-D look
