



The feet move back and forth on this card!

Paper:

- Pumpkin Pie
 - o 8 ½" x 5 ½" scored in half on long side, plus scraps
 - o 5/8" x 1 ½"
- Basic Black
 - o 5 3/8" x 4 1/8"
- Daffodil Delight
 - o 2" x 1 ½"
- Petal Pink Scraps
- Basic White
 - o 5 ½" x 4 ¼"
 - o 5/8" x 1 ½"

Instructions:

- Fold Pumpkin Pie Cardstock in half on score line
- Adhere black panel to card front
- Die cut white panel using Split Card Texture Dies and adhere to card front

- Die cut gnome as shown in video
- Cut 1" x 1" white cardstock and punch a ½" circle in the middle (or a die that is close in that size the gnome nose would work, as well)
- Adhere gnome feet to bottom of this square trim white edge around gnome feet if needed
- Place this piece on card front, placing a Mini Dimensional in the center of this open punched circle as shown in video
- To create the gnome hat made with the gnome dies:
 - Adhere Pumpkin Pie and Basic White cardstock strips to Daffodil Delight cardstock
 - Die cut gnome hat
- Die cut white beard and adhere hat to this piece
- Die cut Petal Pink nose and adhere to beard using Mini Glue Dot
- Adhere gnome to card front, using Mini Glue Dot at the top of the hat and then on the seam
 where the beard and hat meet (don't put Dimensionals lower than that or it will interfere with
 the dancing legs)
- VOILA! Such a fun, interactive card with a moving part! Think of all the seasons you can create with this card!
