## So Very Merry Card

## Paper:

$\square$ Cherry Cobbler

- $7 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ ", scored at 3 " on longer side
- $23 / 4$ " x $23 / 4$ "
$\square$ Very Vanilla
- $23 / 4$ " $\times 23 / 4$ "
- $2 \frac{3}{4}$ " $\times 5 \frac{1}{4}$ "
$\square$ Distressed Gold 12x12 DSP
- $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 8^{\prime \prime}$


## Instructions:

$\square$ Fold cardstock base on score line
$\square$ Emboss front card flap using Snowflake Sky 3D Embossing Folder.
$\square$ Die cut Distressed Gold strip in half, using Gorgeously Made Dies.
$\square$ Adhere $1 / 2$ of this strip to card front
 flap right edge, and the other to back right side of card.
$\square$ Stamp Santa image using Versamark Ink on square Very Vanilla panel.
$\square$ Sprinkle Gold Embossing Powder on this and emboss using Heat Tool. This will give the image a "stained glass" look.
$\square$ Color Santa image using Blends listed above. You can get a more shaded look by coloring the light first, then add darker color below where you just colored.
$\square$ Let it dry a bit and then go over the harsh line between light and dark,
 with the lighter Blend again.
$\square$ Punch Santa out using 2 3/8" Circle Punch.
$\square$ Adhere Santa to Stitched Shape Cherry Cobbler circle, that has been die-cut.
$\square$ Adhere piece of Gold Trim on the back of the Santa circles using Mini Glue Dot.
$\square$ Adhere this piece to card front, using Dimensionals.
$\square$ Adhere the other loose end of Gold Trim to back of front flap, using Mini Glue Dot.
$\square$ Adhere Cherry Cobbler $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Circle on top of the Gold Trim raw edge.
$\square$ Stamp sentiment on Very Vanilla panel, using Cherry Cobbler ink. Adhere to inside of card.
